No-Wake Petition Drive

In September, OYC launched a petition to extend the current No-Wake zone in our cove by about 200 yards north. The petition aims to make the cove more suitable for youth sailing (small 12-ft dinghies) while reducing noise levels and boat speeding in the area as well.

While we experience some resistance, we are confident that our reasonable proposal will eventually prevail.

OYC Expansion Plans

Despite delays due to numerous breakdowns of excavating equipment, the new OYC Parkway is shaping up more exciting than previously imagined, stretching from Bagnell Boulevard through the woods along *Princess Beach* and *Golden Pond* and four tree houses (*Pine, Cedar, Oak, Hickory*) for OYC members' and guest stays.

The approval process for additional spacious dock slips along the added 900-ft shoreline is also moving along. It will give OYC the economies of scale to provide our clients the superior value they expect.

Negotiations with the Department Of Natural Resources are currently under way for OYC to acquire and rejuvenate the unsightly lot at the corner of Flynn and Bagnell Blvd.

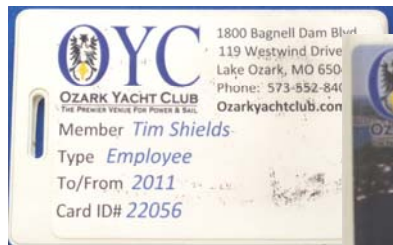

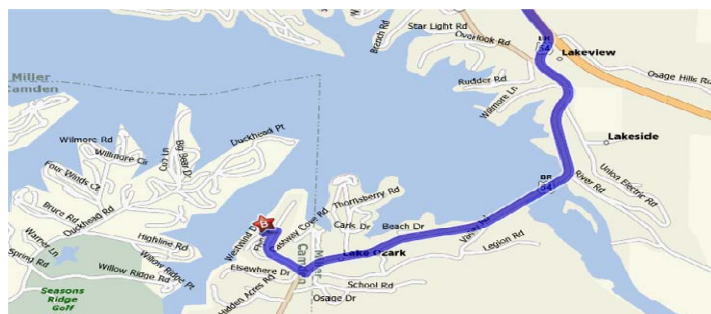
Directions to OYC

The OYC is located on beautiful Lake of the Ozarks, a comfortable 2 hours by car from St. Louis

Coming southwest on Highway 54 from Jefferson City, exit at Bagnell Dam and proceed on **Business 54** one mile across the dam to Flynn Road.

Turn right onto Flynn Road (at the roadside clock). Go 0.2 miles, then turn left onto Westwind Drive. After 0.1 mile you will arrive at the Ozark Yacht Club.

By water, go to the 1-mile marker, turn south into Jennings Branch Cover to Ozark Yacht Club. Use courtesy slips on the fuel dock.
